A Message from the Board President

A year ago, SDC was firmly in the grip of the pandemic. Our enrollment was trending downward, reflecting the country's economic malaise. SDC kids soon got used to seeing their classroom teachers wearing masks, to social distancing, frequent hand washing and temperature taking. A strict

"no visitors" policy that included parents was in place. No matter the temperature, windows in our classrooms were open wide, regardless of the weather, to keep the air circulating and fresh as possible. Despite carefully



following safety protocols, we were forced to close the center several times as the virus struck children, parents and staff.

When Jefferson County schools closed, we were suddenly faced with the reality of "remote learning" for our schoolagers, who were scattered around our downstairs lobby on makeshift seating, "zooming" their classes, and art, gym, music and library sessions, and dealing with our spotty internet. 


